Learn about the defensible space requirements outlined in the California Fire Code (CFC) and Public Resources Code (PRC), and hear directly from fire professionals about the challenges of reducing hazardous vegetation in an urban environment.

We'll have representatives from Marin fire departments, land management agencies like MMWD, County Parks and Open Space, PG&E, and others to help you understand Marin's wildfire risk and develop tools to allow your company to better serve Marin residents and respond to the increased demand for service following California's devastating wildfires.

Contractors and business representatives who attend will have an opportunity for listing in a publication of green industry businesses with distribution to more than 55,000 Marin residents in the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI). Donations to FIRE Safe MARIN are encouraged, but not required.
