The 2023 season is looking good!

ChipperDay highlights thru July

- 2,029 completed pickups county wide so far, 2x more than last year!
- 6,347 cubic yards of vegetation removed
- 79% of residents surveyed reported that the defensible space inspection report helped them identify hazardous vegetation for ChipperDay or green waste bin
- 85% of residents surveyed reported taking action because of the free ChipperDay program
- 91% of residents surveyed rated the ChipperDay program 5/5
