Are you worried about your home's vulnerabilities to wildfire, about your home insurance, about your pet's readiness? Ask our Ambassadors!



Our Ambassadors will be at the Fire Safe Marin tent at events across Marin ready to answer your questions and help you prepare your homes, properties, and families for wildfire. Eleven of them speak Spanish which allows us to expand the people we are able to reach with this valuable information!

As part of the program, ambassadors receive continuing education to keep them current on what's happening in the wildfire preparedness world such as home insurance, the home wildfire risk report, home hardening, and local grants.
