

Defensible Space Evaluations Coming to Your Neighborhood

Hello Neighbors,

Your local fire departments remain committed to collaborating with you on the vegetation management surrounding your homes. This process aims to assist you and your family in achieving a safer evacuation, while also helping slow the spread of wildfire.

Starting June 10th, if conditions permit, neighbors within the **Santa Venetia neighborhood in unincorporated San Rafael** will be receiving Wildfire Defensible Space and Home Hardening Evaluations from our uniformed Fire Inspectors. will be receiving Wildfire Defensible Space and Home Hardening Evaluations from our uniformed Fire Inspectors.

Inspectors will confirm that you have completed the *vegetation maintenance required by law*. They will also provide recommendations for steps that may provide additional protection from wildfires. Property owners are required to maintain their properties' vegetation at all times during fire season and should not wait for an inspection to begin work.


Online reports are only available to property owners, renters, and authorized representatives.
