## FIRE SMART YARD CHECKLIST

Did you know that most home ignitions are caused by burning embers that start fires in yards that spread to the home? You can prevent this! Creating and maintaining a firesmart yard will protect your home and neighborhood. Follow this weekly checklist to keep your home safe.

If you contract someone to care for your yard, review this checklist with them. And remember - the key to fire safety is maintenance, maintenance, maintenance!

## **CLEAR ZONE 0 LIMB UP TREES & TRIM BRANCHES** Remove combustible items within the first 5 Prevent fire from spreading from the ground to tree tops by removing the lowest branches feet around the house of the trees to at least 6 feet Remove hazardous plants like juniper, Italian cypress and bamboo Keep bushes and plants low beneath trees to avoid "fire ladders" Use non-combustible mulch, like gravel, Remove dead branches stones or pavers ☐ Trim branches 10 feet from the roof **REMOVE LEAVES AND DEBRIS FROM RAISE "SKIRTS" OF BUSHES & HEDGES** ☐ Zone 0 ☐ Trimming bushes a couple feet from the ground will allow you to keep the bed beneath Gutters clear of leaves Rooftops ☐ Beneath bushes **KEEP SPACE BETWEEN PLANTS** ☐ Under decks and staircases ☐ Thin out bushes and plantings to allow space Behind garage or sheds between plants to prevent the spread of fire Weed and clean beds regularly
