Maintaining a fire smart yard will protect your home. Follow this weekly checklist to keep your home safe. Zone 0 is the first 5 ft next to your house and is critical to protecting your home.

If you contract someone to care for your yard, review this checklist with them. And remember – the key to fire safety is **maintenance**, **maintenance**, **maintenance**!
