June is National Pet Preparedness Month. As you get your family ready for wildfire season, don't forget your pets!

Here are 4 things recommended by Marin Humane that you can do to prepare your pets.

- 1. Pack a go bag for you, AND an additional go bag for your animals. Here's a <u>checklist</u> to help you get started.
- 2. Make sure your pets microchips are registered with up to date information and engraved ID tags on collars are current.
- 3. Practice what to do during a <u>Red Flag warning</u>. This is the time to get yourself ready to evacuate at a moment's notice. This means grab the go bags, including crates and kennels. Help your pets to become more familiarized with the routine now so you will all be ready to go if needed.
- 4. Create an emergency contact list that includes family, friends, a few neighbors, our veterinarian, nearby animal shelters and several pet-friendly hotels. Include this list in your go-bag.

In a wildfire emergency, every second counts, especially for our pets so make a plan and think ahead!
