To your neighborhood...

Dear Neighbors,

The **Marin Wildfire Prevention Authority** and your **local fire department** are working together to help reduce wildfire risk in your community. As part of this effort, **home hardening and defensible space evaluations** will take place in your neighborhood.

Starting as early as **the week of May 5, 2025**, the **Los Ranchitos and California Park neighborhoods of San Rafael** will undergo wildfire risk evaluations conducted by trained Inspectors acting under the **authority of the local Fire Chief**. If you are not home, inspectors will assess only what is visible from the street to your front door.

Your Wildfire Risk Report

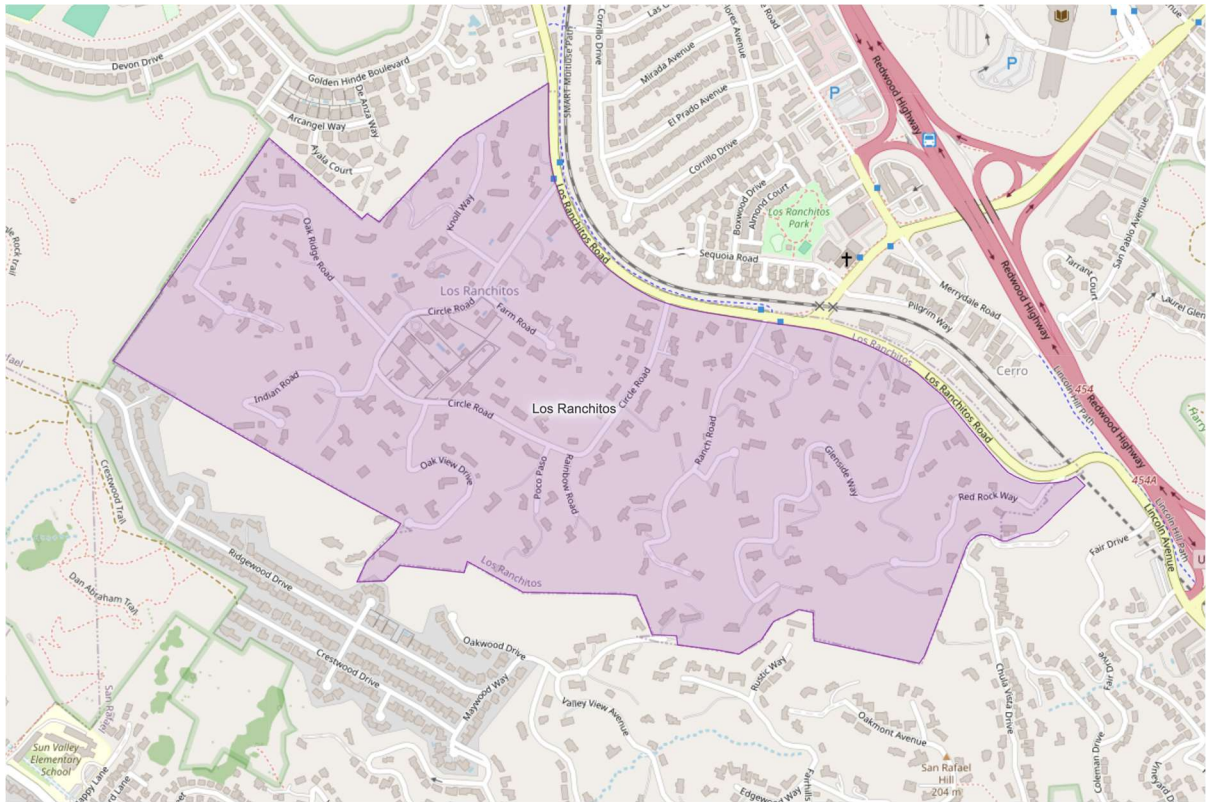
Approximately **24 hours after inspection**, your personalized **Wildfire Risk Report** will be available. This report provides **clear steps to improve your home's wildfire resilience**. Some actions may be **required by law**, and all property owners must **maintain vegetation year-round**—*don't wait for an inspection to begin necessary work*.

How to Access Your Report

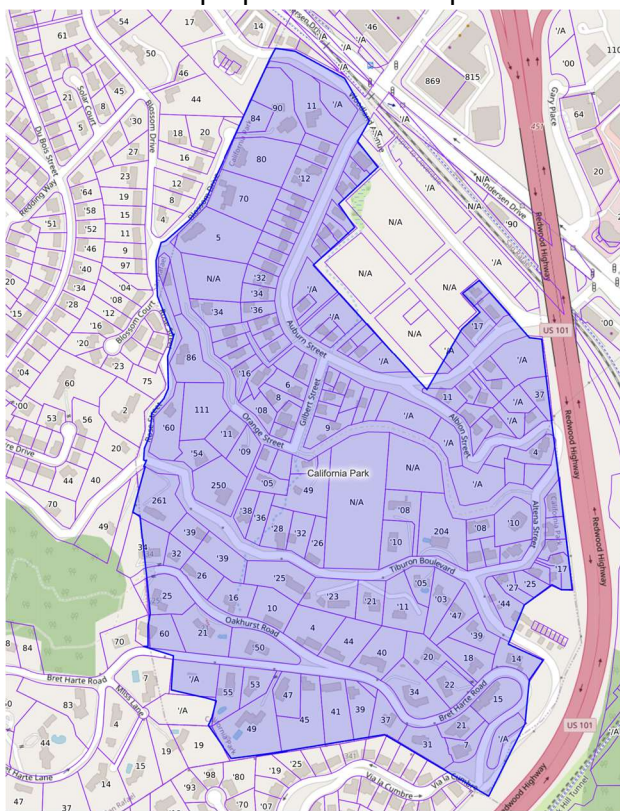
- **Online:** Visit www.defensiblespacereport.org/marin to review your report and access resources.
- **By Mail:** Request a printed copy by calling **(415) 275-1185**.
- **Eligibility:** Reports are available to **property owners, renters, and authorized representatives**.
